Prayer for the Intentions of the Holy Father vs. Prayer for the Holy Father

In order to gain a plenary indulgence, in most cases the Church requires that the "usual conditions" be observed -- confession, Holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father. Very often those participating in an act eligible for a plenary indulgence might hear the leader of the pious exercise announce something along the lines of "prayer for our Holy Father." This is technically not what is called for. It is important that we realize that we are praying for that for which the Holy Father wishes us to pray, not for his person. We should, of course, pray for his person as well, that God assist him in the burden of ruling the universal Church.

It is not necessary to know the specific intention for which one is praying to fulfill this condition to gain the indulgence. The Holy Father publishes his intentions in the Vatican newspaper L'Osservatore Romano. There is always a general intention and one specific to the missions.
