COMMUNICANTES (cont.)

(Taken from Notes Made at the Conferences of Dom Prosper Guéranger).

She terminates her Prayer by naming all the Saints, by whose merits she commends herself to God: et omnium Sanctorum tuorum, quorum meritis precibusque concedas, ut in omnibus protectionis tuae muniamur auxilio. [and all Thy Saints; by whose merits and prayers grant that we may in all things be made secure by the aid of Thy protection. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.]

Thus ends this third Prayer, which is, like the other two, a Prayer of recommendation. First of all, the Priest prayed for Holy Church, the Pope, the Bishop, all Catholics, then for those for whose intention the Holy Sacrifice is being offered; to these he joined other persons in whom he is interested, finally, he reminded God of the union which exists between the Church Militant and the Church Triumphant, and then the names of the Saints in Heaven were heard at our Altar here below. These three Prayers form but one, for which reason, only at the conclusion of this third, the Priest, joining his hands, terminates with the usual words: Per eundem Christum Dominum nostrum. Amen. He says the Amen himself and in a whisper; his voice is not to be heard, until the Pater.

St. Edmund Campion Missal and Hymnal

Propers for today's Mass can be found starting on page 5 in the Campion Missal/Hymnal. For the most part, the Sundays follow a sequential order. The name of the Sunday is listed in the bulletin, so that you can find it in the missal part of the book. Occasional Masses that appear on specific dates (e.g. holy days of obligation or other major feasts) are found from pages 431-531. If you have not already done so, please take a few minutes to look through the book to familiarize yourself with where things are. Eventually we will discontinue using the loose proper sheets and red booklet missals.

MASS REQUESTS

If you desire a Mass to be celebrated for a particular intention, please place the offering along with the specific intention in writing in an envelope clearly marked **Mass Intention** and place it in the collection basket. For individual intentions, make sure to specify whether the person is living or deceased.

Alternatively, you can approach the pastor or bring or mail the request to the church. We do not accept phoned-in or emailed requests. Everything must be together at the time the request is made. Please note that Mass stipends are NOT tax-deductible according to IRS regulations.

If you would like to schedule your Masses for next year we are full through February 2018 with a few open Masses for March & April, 2018.

The Bella House - Part I

In 2012, two pregnancy counselors at the Birth Choice Women’s Center in Dallas, Texas, faced dilemma. Once a client had chosen life for her baby, then what? Often she was without financial or medical resources to bring her baby to term. Even more challenging, often she had no place to stay during her pregnancy and no one to support her life-affirming, but difficult, decision. Out of this dilemma came a vision, the vision of The Bella House. The word “bella” means beautiful, and as its name implies, The Bella House “celebrates the beauty of every life.”

After nearly two years of prayer, fund-raising, and strategic planning, The Bella House in the suburb of Plano opened its doors as a transitional home, a safe haven of hospitality, loving care, and personal growth. Its mission was to reach and support a largely underserved segment of our population, the homeless, pregnant woman. Fundamental to the Bella House mission is the belief that true transformation can only occur in an atmosphere of authentic love, namely, the love of God reflected in the good works of a loving people.

Mothers can come to Bella House when they are newly pregnant, and can stay up to six months after their baby is born. To date, 19 women have come through its doors. A few have left before giving birth because they have found permanent housing, or have reconciled with the baby’s father or their families. Every mother has said she is better for having been at The Bella House, even if her stay was not that long. See more about “The Bella House” in next week’s bulletin.
