The Direction of Prayer

"Corresponding with the manner of the sun's rising, prayers are made looking toward the sunrise in the East" (Clement of Alexandria).

Although the design of Sacred Heart is admittedly modern in many ways, while still retaining most of the elements that go into a Catholic Church -- the floor does not slope downwards in the direction of the altar in the manner of a movie theater, for example, nor is the church built in a circle with the altar in the middle - - we have been blessed with one thing which many churches, even some of the more beautiful ones, have not. Sacred Heart is properly "oriented." The Latin deponent verb oriri, of which oriens is the present participle, means "rising," referring to the rising of the sun. This means that when Mass is celebrated in the Traditional manner with the priest praying in the same direction as the people, all are facing east toward the rising sun.

Fr. Joseph Jungmann comments: "Just as the church of God is built up of people and clergy, so too the presbytery or choir [where the clergy and servers sit -Fr. W]... is separated from the nave of the church. Just as the ecclesiastical assembly, following ancient custom, was wont to pray facing East, toward the orient from on High, so too the ecclesiastical building is turned into a "ship" (nave = navis) voyaging toward the East, and the orientation of the church is in fact carried out in such a way (first in the East and later in the West) that the apse is to the east, and so the direction which the praying congregation faces coincides with the lie of the building.

Even though only the priest is capable of making the heavenly sacrifice present upon the altar, once it is there, it is the church as a whole that offers it to God, with the priest leading. Every person in the congregation, according to his state, offers the Divine Victim, always pleasing to God, and so we all face in the same direction
