Sacred Heart Devotions

To foster devotion to the Sacred Heart in our parish, the Litany of the Sacred Heart will be chanted in Latin after Mass each Friday. Side-by-side English translations will be available. It is the pastor's hope that the congregation can begin to learn some of the beautiful titles for the Sacred Heart both in Latin and in English. The Litany of the Precious Blood, one of the other approved litanies will also be prayed (in English, as no chant exists). Sheets will be available in church with these prayers. The Sorrowful Mother Novena is discontinued, since it is not a perpetual novena, as it is suspended every year during Lent. Anyone can continue to make this devotion privately, as the prayer books indicate. On First Fridays, there will also be exposition and benediction of the Blessed Sacrament after Mass with these and additional prayers, including some of the Confraternity of St. Peter prayers. Consequently the monthly Holy Hour is discontinued.

Low Mass

Although the Solemn High Mass (or the Solemn Pontifical Mass), with deacon and subdeacon assisting, is the presumed form for the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass in the Roman Rite, over the centuries the celebration of private or "Low" Masses increased. Pope Leo III was said to have sometimes offered the Sacrifice 7 times in one day. So as not to cheapen the value of the Sacrifice in the eyes of the faithful and priest alike, the practice and ultimately the law of the church developed that each priest could celebrate Mass only once per day. This law was very strictly adhered to for many centuries, with permission to celebrate more than one Mass a day rarely given and only in exceptional circumstances. The law has been loosened in recent years to allow priests to celebrate a second time especially on Sundays or Holy Days, or even a third time if circumstances demand it, but the ideal is a single celebration.

Unfortunately, parallel to this development of the Low Mass was the lack of appreciation for the more Solemn forms of liturgy, such that in parish churches, even on Sundays and Holy Days, the faithful would fulfill their obligation at a Low Mass.

Fr. Jungmann comments: "With us the private Mass has, in the last analysis, almost completely doffed its private character, gaining public recognition and in fact becoming simply the Mass... This strange phenomenon is on a par with the fact that at the beginning of the modern period the older solemn forms suddenly begin to lose some of the stateliness and the simplified forms partly replace them."

Let us at Sacred Heart never settle for "good enough" with regards to the liturgy, either in its execution or in our participation. It is perhaps too late to restore the High Mass to its rightful place as the typical form, especially since the Roman Church has adopted the custom of the daily celebration of Mass for the glory of God and the salvation of souls, but we should at least assist at it with as much devotion as we can, uniting ourselves with the priest as perfectly as possible, and assisting at those Masses that we ourselves have requested to be celebrated whenever possible.

To cut down on overhead expenses, we will be discontinuing the use of collection envelopes. 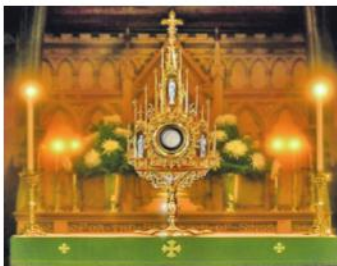
