SATURDAY, SEPT. 8 — BIRTHDAY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY — BLESSING OF SEEDS AND SEEDLINGS

On September 8, the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Church traditionally blesses seed and seedlings, marking the end of the summer harvest and the new planting season for the fall and winter. Anyone who has seeds or small plants may bring them to be blessed. This blessing will take place after Mass this Saturday. The text of the blessing is as follows:

BLESSING OF SEED AND SEEDLINGS

on the Birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary

V: Our help is in the name of the Lord.

R: Who made heaven and earth.

V: The Lord be with you.

R: And with thy spirit.

blessing,  and may be gathered unharmed and stored up in the granary; through Christ our Lord.

FIRST FRIDAY

A reminder that this Friday is the First Friday of the month.

Our Lord made the following promise to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque: "I promise you in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who shall receive communion on the First Friday in nine consecutive months the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment."

Friday -- Confessions at 5:30 pm, Mass at 6 pm followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Sacred Heart devotions and Benediction.

UPCOMING SERIES ON THE SACRED LITURGY

There will be a series of talks offered by the pastor on the sacred liturgy, covering the church, altar and its appurtenances, the vestments used, and finally the prayers and ceremonies of the Traditional Latin Mass. These will take place after the 6 PM Mass on 6 Wednesdays in the fall, (Sept. 26, Oct. 3, 10, 17, Nov. 7 and 14) and 6 Wednesdays in the Spring (to be

determined). This is a great opportunity not only to learn more about the Latin Mass, but also to invite any friends or relatives who might have questions or curiosity, or even misapprehensions regarding the Latin Mass, and this may allow the pastor to be able to answer the same repeated common questions and objections that many people raise at various times and in divers places.

In order to make it easier for families to attend the teaching series on the Liturgy and the Mass, we will be providing a pizza dinner and beverages directly after Mass and before the teaching. To supplement the pizza, we are asking people to bring a salad/veggie type side dish if your last name begins with the letters A-L and a dessert if your last name begins with the letters M-Z.
