REGULATIONS FOR LENT

Just a reminder that abstinence from meat is observed on all Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years of age and older. This is considered a grave obligation, and “substituting another penance” cannot be done during Lent unless a dispensation is obtained. The older regulations are given at the end of this bulletin for those who wish to observe Lent in a more traditional manner.

Our Blessed Mother made the following promise to Sr. Lucia: "I promise to assist at the hour of death with the grace necessary for salvation all those who, with the intention of making reparation to me, will, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months, go to confession, receive Holy Communion, say five decades of the beads, and keep me company for fifteen minutes while meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary."
