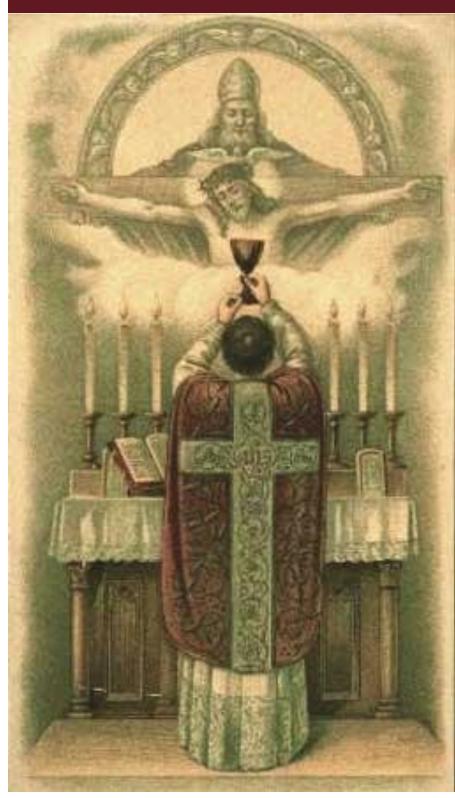

ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST (JUNE 24)

(From Religious Customs in the Family by Fr. F. X. Weiser, S.J.)

He was highly honored throughout the Church from the very beginning. Since he was "filled with the Holy Ghost even from his mother's womb" (Luke 1:15), he was born with sanctifying grace in his soul; therefore, the Church now cele-brates his earthly birthday. So great was the rank of his feast in the Middle Ages that three Masses were celebrated, just as on Christmas.

The holy Baptist is patron of tailors (because he made

his own garments in the desert), of shepherds (because he spoke of the "Lamb of God") and of masons (because he exhorted people to build the "road of the Lord"). Above all, however, he is an example and patron of self-denial and of doing your duty, even if it hurts. This brings the Saint very close to children, who have to learn this very lesson and will greatly appreciate his help.

PARISH EMAIL LOOP

There exists a google group for the parish, so that parishioners can more easily share prayer requests, announcements, and other information with each other. This can be found at groups.google.com/group/sacred-heart -fort-wayne If you wish to be added to this group, simply log in to a google account, go to the above link, and click the "Request to be added to the group" button. Note that if you do not wish to receive further emails from the group, you can opt out, and you can also read the past posts to the group there. To submit a message to the group, send it by email to sacred-heart-fortwayne@googlegroups.com If you do not have and do not wish to have a google account, you can request to be added to the loop with your existing email address. Simply email sacredheartfortwayne@gmail.com with your request to be added. You can then continue to submit news items as mentioned above. Please put "for the email loop" or some such specifying verbiage in the subject line when you submit items.

MASS REQUESTS

If you desire a Mass to be celebrated for a particular intention, please place the offering along with the specific intention in writing in an envelope clearly marked **Mass Intention** and place it in the collection basket or hand it to the priest. For intentions for a specific individual, make sure to specify whether the person is living or deceased. Alternatively, you can approach the pastor or bring or mail the request to the church. We do not accept telephoned or emailed requests. Everything must be together at the time the request is made. Please note that Mass stipends are NOT tax-deductible according to IRS regulations.
