ST. LUCY'S WHEAT

There are many legends and customs which surround the Feast of St. Lucy on December 13.

A beautiful Hungarian tradition on this day is to plant the 'Christmas Wheat.' Pressed gently into a pot of garden soil, watered and kept in a moderately warm room, the wheat will be sprouted soft green by Christmas. Then the children may carry it to the creche as a gift for the Child Jesus, symbolic of the Eucharistic bread by which He feeds our souls at the altar as well as of the staff of life by which His Father keeps life in our bodies.(Taken from *The Year and Our Children* by Mary Reed Newland) If you are interested in beginning this custom in your own home, small bags of wheat are available in the back of the church.

St. Lucy, pray for us, that our eye may be purified, and may see, in the Child who is to be born at Bethlehem, the new Man, the second Adam, the model on which the life of our regeneration must be formed.
