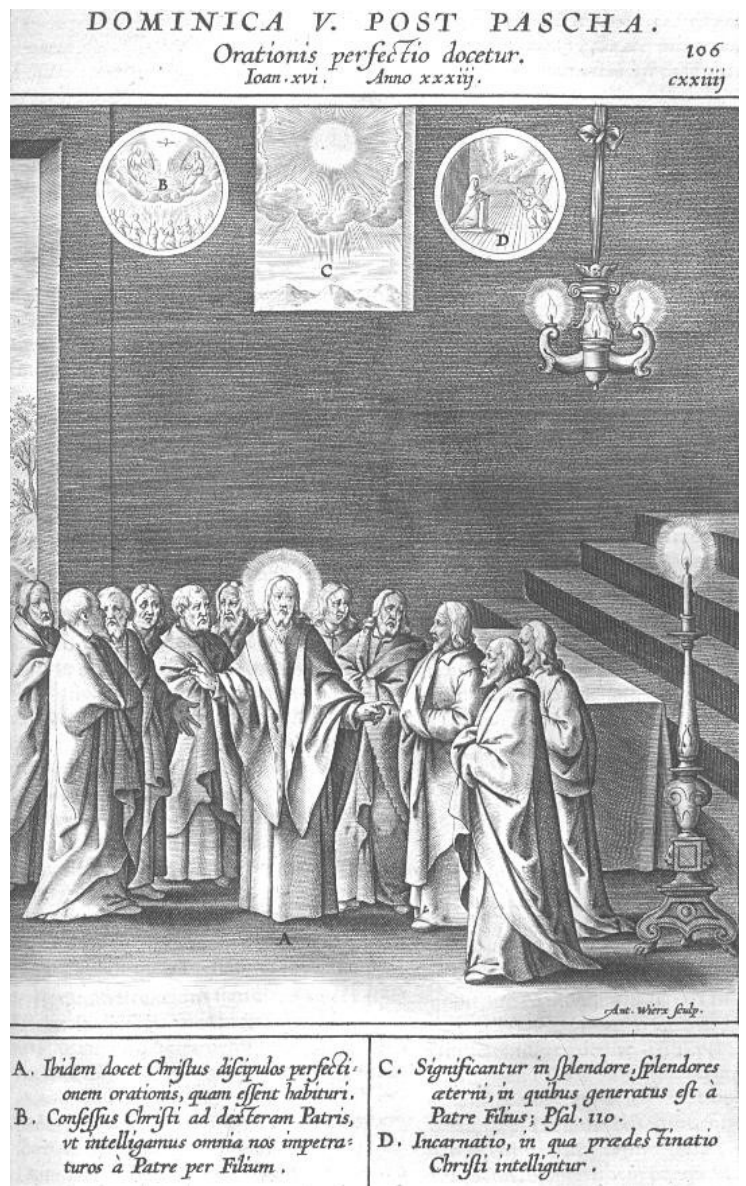

UPDATE ON SHUTDOWN

It appears that there is no prohibition against some of the parish groups resuming activity, as they are small enough in size, specifically the young ladies' group, the women's group, and the Militia of St. Joseph. Because of its large number of participants, the Troops of St. George will have to wait until May 24 to resume operation according to the plan devised by the state.

DRESS IN CHURCH

Entry to the church is forbidden for those not conforming to the standards of Christian modesty, including wearing the following: Clothing with a low neckline, sleeveless garments which expose the shoulders, clothing that exposes the knees or upper legs

(whether sitting or standing), clothing that exposes the stomach or back, extremely tight-fitting clothing or clothing made of see-through material. All of this information appears on the signs on the doors.

For more information on the virtue of modesty in dress and the true ideal to which we as Catholics should strive, various materials are available in the back of church. Please check from time to time for new arrivals. There are many online businesses that sell affordable clothing that is also decent.
