


Active registered parishioners should contact the Pastor at least six Months in advance of the date.



Translation of today's gospel image captions:

- A. Mount Tabor and the flat area where Christ is teaching
- B. For the first part of the gospel, a pious man is described. He is focused on heaven, where he stores up his treasure
- C. The other, completely focused on perishable goods, anxiously obtains such goods, money, house, and copious furnishings
- D. Jesus bids us to look at the birds, which God feeds though they do not have concern for food
- E. Then the splendor of the lilies, which neither work nor spin
- F. The meadow clothed with grass and flowers (see the worker throwing them in the furnace)
- G. Solomon cannot compare to these, though magnificently clothed in his own house.
- A. From this He teaches: Be not solicitous therefore,

saying, What shall we eat: or what shall we drink, or wherewith shall we be clothed? . . . Seek ye therefore first the kingdom of God, and his justice, and all these things shall be added unto you.
