FRIDAYS OF LENT

We are offering a simple meatless supper on the Fridays of Lent (February 19 and 26; March 5, 12 and 26th) following Stations of the Cross at 6:00 pm and Mass at 6:30 pm. **NO STATIONS OF THE CROSS OR SUPPER ON FRIDAY, MARCH 19, THE FEAST OF ST. JOSEPH.** On the 5 Fridays we have a meatless supper, the Church will provide drinks and some of the food but we need people to pitch in and sign up to bring other dishes. There are detailed **SIGN UP SHEETS for all five Fridays of Lent** on a blue clipboard on the table by the west entrance that specify what kind of dish to bring. *Please sign up to bring a dish on as many Fridays as you can!*

Please join your fellow parishioners for coffee and donuts after the 8:00 AM Mass on the first Sunday of the month, or after the 10:00 AM Mass on the first and third Sundays of the month. This is also the time to visit our small lending library of good Catholic books and media. This is located on the first floor of the school building (Classroom #5).

Blessing of religious objects takes place after Mass on the third Sunday of every month. Please leave your objects on the designated table in the school basement.

REGULATIONS FOR LENT

The following are the barest minimum obligations which must be observed by Catholics under pain of serious sin (if there is no serious excusing cause). Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years of age and older. Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 years of age. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meatless meal. Two smaller meals, not equaling together a full meal, are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. If there are any questions about when one would not be obliged to this observance, please ask the pastor.

PRAYER BEFORE A CRUCIFIX

BEHOLD, O good and sweetest Jesus, I cast myself upon my knees in Thy sight, and with the most fervent desire of my soul I pray and beseech Thee to impress upon my heart lively sentiments of faith, hope and charity, with true repentance for my sins and a most firm

desire of amendment: whilst with deep affection and grief of soul I consider within myself and mentally contemplate Thy five most precious Wounds, having before mine eyes that which David, the prophet, long ago spoke in Thine own person concerning Thee, my Jesus: They have pierced my hands and my feet, they have numbered all my bones [Psalm 21, 17, 18].

Say Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be for the intentions of the Holy Father. A plenary indulgence, under the usual conditions, may be gained by those who shall say this prayer with devotion after receiving Holy Communion on any Friday of Lent.

ORA ET LABORA

A list of small tasks as well as cleaning and maintenance needs has been put together and the standard cleaning crew and a few others of the parish would like to get together just before Easter to address them. There are also plans to patch some of the asphalt from the winter damage, and tidy up the stairwells that fill in with trash and leaves every year.
