It will serve, mainly, as a social group with talks from our priests, activities for kids, planned field trips, networking, and curriculum talks for moms! Meetings take place on the second Thursday of each month and snacks will be provided. Our parish life is thriving with a growing number of groups meeting regularly in the parish center. At this point in time, let us be reminded how necessary it is to properly clean up after each group meeting or gathering of any kind – this includes every area we use in the parish center, and most especially when food is involved. **Sweep, wash table surfaces, wipe down chairs, wash dishes, empty drain guards of food from washed dishes, empty trash and replace with new garbage bags. Craft debris, toys, etc. should be cleaned up and picked up. There is to be NO FOOD OR DRINK in the Library.**

Following these directions are a matter of charity in community life, so please be conscientious and help your children learn the rules, too. There are directions for cleaning the parish hall and kitchen posted on the door to the pantry and the leaders of groups in the parish will receive a handout with these details. All the other areas only require some charitable thinking and common sense. *Many thanks to those people who regularly pitch in to help clean after potlucks, groups and such.*
