


Active registered parishioners should contact the Pastor at least six Months in advance of the date.

MASS REQUESTS

If you desire a Mass to be celebrated for a particular intention, please place the offering along with the specific intention in writing in an envelope clearly marked **Mass Intention** and place it in the collection basket or hand it to the priest. For intentions for a specific individual, make sure to specify whether the person is living or deceased. Alternatively, you can approach the pastor or bring or mail the request to the

church. We do not accept telephoned or emailed requests. Everything must be together at the time the request is made. Please note that Mass stipends are NOT tax-deductible according to IRS regulations.

PARISH EMAIL LOOP

There exists a google group for the parish, so that parishioners can more easily share prayer requests, announcements, and other information with each other. To submit a message to the group, send it by email to sacred-heartfort-wayne@googlegroups.com If you do not have and do not wish to have a google account, you can request to be added to the loop with your existing email address. Simply email <u>sacredheartfortwayne@gmail.com</u> with your request to be added. You can then continue to submit news items as mentioned above. Please put "for the email loop" or some such specifying verbiage in the subject line when you submit items.
