


Active registered parishioners should contact the Pastor at least six Months in advance of the date.

PARISH CENTER — PLEASE READ

We are at a point where we need to create some new rules for the Parish Center: the kitchen, parish hall, big hall/gym, Library and the entire building. This is for the safety and well being of all members of Sacred Heart and we ask that parents are very clear with their children on these rules and that parents enforce them.

First, a big thank you to everyone who has been working at cleaning up after groups and events – there is definitely a noticeable difference. Here are new

guidelines and rules that will be posted in the Parish Center Hall soon:

- -Families and individuals are responsible to clean their eating areas after every event, including Coffee and Donuts: Wash table area, wash chairs, sweep under table area and around chairs. There are buckets and rags in the kitchen that should be placed in the hall by event coordinators.
- -Children are not to roam and run around the building.
- -Parental supervision is required at all times in the big hall and toddler play area. Parents need to watch behaviors and redirect when necessary.
- -Children 10 and under may NOT be in the Library without an adult. No food or drink in the Library.
- -No FOOD OR DRINK in the big hall unless there is a supervised event and clean up is expected as in the parish hall. Adults may take their coffee into big hall to supervise their children
- -Kitchen: No children under 12 years of age in the kitchen unless there is an adult supervised project.

MASS REQUESTS

If you desire a Mass to be celebrated for a particular intention, please place the offering along with the specific intention in writing in an envelope clearly marked **Mass Intention** and place it in the collection basket or hand it to the priest. For intentions for a specific individual, make sure to specify whether the person is living or deceased. Alternatively, you can approach the pastor or bring or mail the request to the church. We do not accept telephoned or emailed requests. Everything must be together at the time the request is made. Please note that Mass stipends are NOT tax-deductible according to IRS regulations.
