

#### PARISH CENTER — PLEASE READ

We are at a point where we need to create some new rules for the Parish Center: the kitchen, parish hall, big hall/gym, Library and the entire building. This is for the safety and well being of all members of Sacred Heart and we ask that parents are very clear with their children on these rules and that parents enforce them.

First, a big thank you to everyone who has been working at cleaning up after groups and events – there is definitely a noticeable difference. Here are new guidelines and rules that will be posted in the Parish Center Hall soon:

- -Families and individuals are responsible to clean their eating areas after every event, including Coffee and Donuts: Wash table area, wash chairs, sweep under table area and around chairs. There are buckets and rags in the kitchen that should be placed in the hall by event coordinators.
- -Children are not to roam and run around the building.
- -Parental supervision is required at all times in the big hall and toddler play area. Parents need to watch behaviors and redirect when necessary.
- -Children 10 and under may NOT be in the Library without an adult. No food or drink in the Library.
- -No FOOD OR DRINK in the big hall unless there is a supervised event and clean up is expected as in the parish hall. Adults may take their coffee into big hall to supervise their children.
- -Kitchen: No children under 12 years of age in the kitchen unless there is an adult supervised project.

In order to better accommodate those with dietary restrictions at our potluck meals, we would like to gauge

#### St. Vincent de Paul "Brown Bag Collection"

Please continue to help our food bank here at Sacred Heart by taking a brown bag and filling it with non perishable foods. Every Friday the St. Henry-Sacred Heart St. Vincent de Paul Society has a food bank that is open to anyone living in the Fort Wayne area. Please bring the filled bag back by the 2nd Sunday of each month and it will be exchanged with another empty brown bag. This gives everyone an opportunity to help feed the poor in our city with this corporal work of mercy. Thanks in advance to all those who help keep the food bank in operation. Please note that though the food bank has moved to St. Henry's for the convenience of the patrons, we nevertheless continue to assist it.

The Kroger Community Rewards Program has earned Sacred Heart \$209.65 for the last quarter, with 56 households participating. #### MASS REQUESTS

If you desire a Mass to be celebrated for a particular intention, please place the offering along with the specific intention in writing in an envelope clearly marked **Mass Intention** and place it in the collection basket or hand it to the priest. For intentions for a specific individual, make sure to specify whether the person is living or deceased. Alternatively, you can approach the pastor or bring or mail the request to the church. We do not accept telephoned or emailed requests. Everything must be together at the time the request is made. Please note that Mass stipends are NOT tax-deductible according to IRS regulations.
