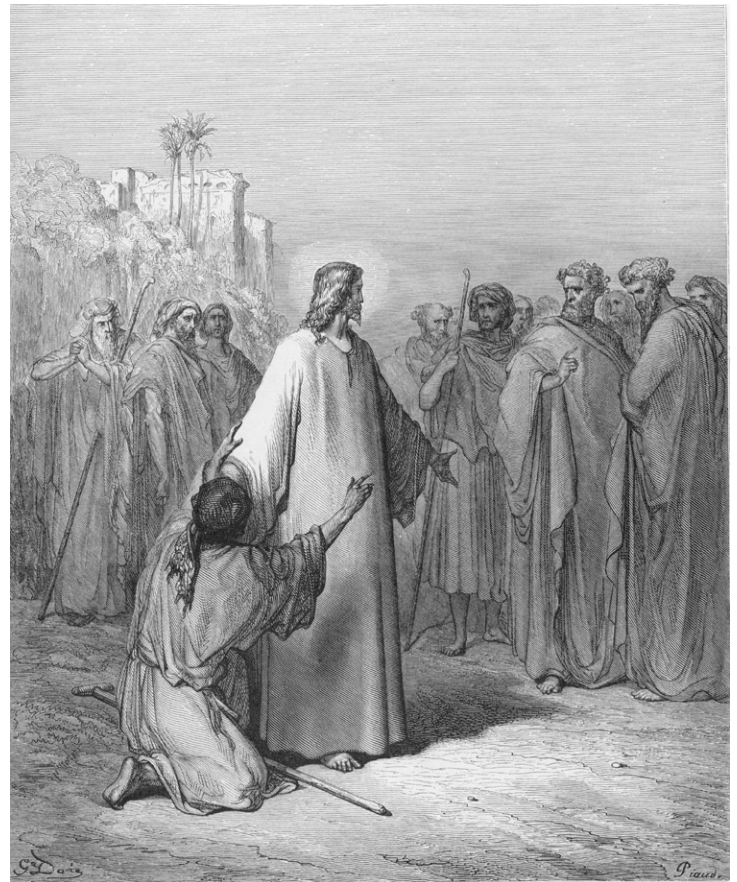

REGULATIONS FOR LENT

Lent began on Ash Wednesday, Mar. 2. The following are the barest minimum obligations which must be observed by Catholics under pain of serious sin (if there is no serious excusing cause). Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years of age and older.

Please join your fellow parishioners for coffee and donuts after the 8:00 AM Mass on the first Sunday of the month, or after the 10:00 AM Mass on the first and third Sundays of the month. This is also the time to visit our small lending library of good Catholic books and media. This is located on the first floor of the school building (Classroom #5).

Blessing of religious objects takes place after Mass on the third Sunday of every month. Please leave your objects on the designated table in the school basement.

Third Sunday of Lent

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 years of age. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meatless meal. Two smaller meals, not equaling together a full meal, are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. If there are any questions about when one would not be obliged to this observance, please ask the pastor. The older regulations are given at the end of this bulletin for those who wish to observe Lent in a more traditional manner.

Please remember, in the interest of safety, children are not to be on the second floor of the school building (where the library and choir practice room are) unsupervised, and there is no reason for anyone to be on the top floor.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

There will be Stations of the Cross each Friday evening during Lent beginning at 6 PM, followed by Mass at 6:30 PM. Please join us for this special Lenten devotion. Normal First Friday devotions will be suspended during Lent.

+FRIDAYS OF LENT+: We are offering a simple meatless supper on the Fridays of Lent (March 4, 11, 18, 25 and April 1 and 8) following Stations of the Cross at 6:00 pm and Mass at 6:30 pm.

The Church will provide drinks and some of the food but we need people to pitch in and sign up to bring DESIGNATED FOOD.

There are detailed **SIGN UP SHEETS for all Six Fridays of Lent** on a blue clipboard on the table by the west entrance that specify what kind of dish to bring. **THIS IS NOT A REGULAR TYPE OF POTLUCK – NO DESSERTS AND ONLY BRING FOOD DESIGNATED ON THE SIGN UP SHEETS.** *Please sign up to bring a dish on as many Fridays as you can!* Contact person: Cate @ 260-402-7740

OLDER LENTEN REGULATIONS FOR DEVOTIONAL PURPOSES (NO LONGER BINDING ON THE CONSCIENCES OF CATHOLICS)

Fasting was observed on all days of Lent, Sundays excepted. Contrary to what many believe and what many currently available "traditional" calendars claim, this even applied to major feast days (St. Joseph and the Annunciation), in order to preserve the integrity of the forty days of fast. Complete abstinence from meat was observed on Fridays and the Ember Days of Lent. Partial abstinence (meat allowed once) was observed on the remaining days. Although these regulations no longer bind, anyone able to do so is exhorted to follow the more strict, traditional fast and abstinence during the season of Lent. Although not as meritorious as when it was required by the Church, because now only the virtue of temperance, but not obedience, is being exercised, fasting is still a valuable means to bring the appetites under control and free the mind to contemplate higher things, as long as any temptation to pride is avoided, as the Pharisee who boasted about his observance of fasting.
