VISITING MISSIONARIES — SEPT. 4

We will be visited by our annual mission visitors on September 4. These Nigerian sisters met with the pastor while passing through and were very impressive and joyful (and Catholic). They are not located far from our FSSP apostolate in Orlu diocese Here is the summary of their work:

MISSIONARY DAUGHTERS OF THE ETERNAL FATHER

Missionary Daughters of the Eternal Father is a congregation known for the work of evangelization. We live a life of perfect charity through caring for the poor, the sick, the aged, the widows, and the prisoners. We also evangelize through the provision of education to the less privileged, the neglected and abused young girls.

The Missionary Daughters of the Eternal Father is a 501-C, non-profit organization in the United States of America. Our sisters and volunteers in different parts of Africa reach out to the Orphans, the poor, the sick, the blind, and the physically challenged by providing them with wheel chairs, crutches, walking sticks, medications, education, housing, food, clothing, diapers, transportations, personal care, and financial assistance. The increased government insensitivity to the needs of

the people, marginalization, insecurity, and high cost of living in some African countries, pump up the number of the poor and less privileged who look upon us for assistance and survival. We do not receive any form of payment or government subsidy for our outreach programs. We have the zeal to reach out to a greater number of people in need but we are challenged by financial constraints. Since our work is missionary and we depend on the good will and generosity of the people of God, especially in our Catholic faith, we are happy that we are been given the opportunity to let people know about our mission in your parish/diocese. Through your generosity we will be able to provide some of the needs of those destitute who benefit from our ministry.

St. Vincent de Paul “Brown Bag Collection”

Please continue to help our food bank here at Sacred Heart by taking a brown bag and filling it with non perishable foods. Every Friday the St. Henry-Sacred Heart St. Vincent de Paul Society has a food bank that is open to anyone living in the Fort Wayne area. Please bring the filled bag back by the 2nd Sunday of each month and it will be exchanged with another empty brown bag. This gives everyone an opportunity to help feed the poor in our city with this corporal work of mercy. Thanks in advance to all those who help keep the food bank in operation. Please note that though the food bank has moved to St. Henry’s for the convenience of the patrons, we nevertheless continue to assist it.
