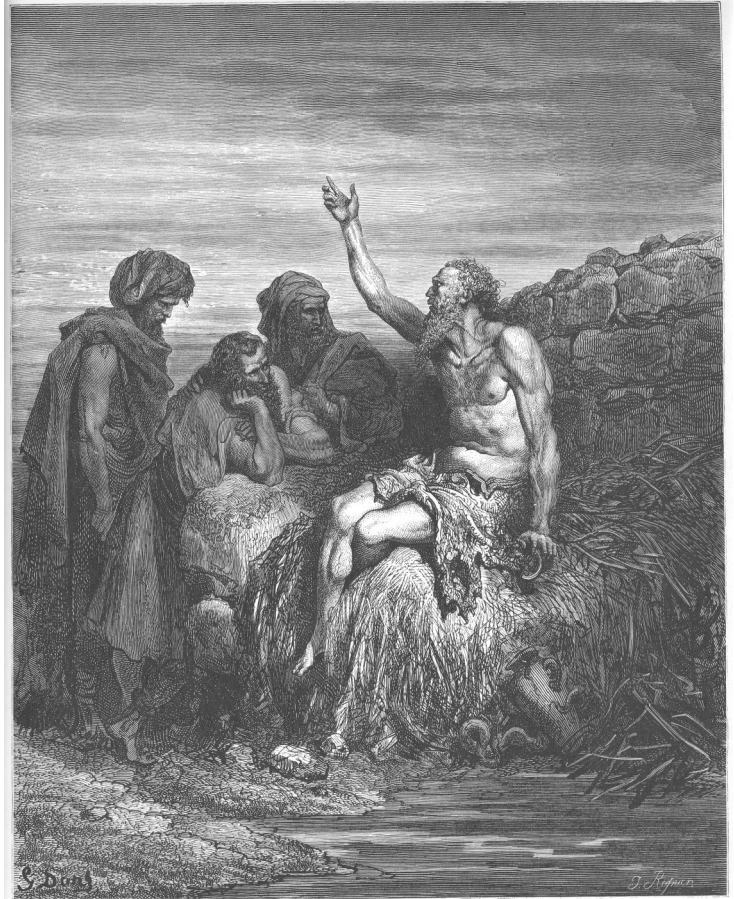

36th ANNUAL BISHOP'S APPEAL

Our Annual Bishop's Appeal kicks off next week in our parish (but why wait?) Our goal for this year is \$17,980.15. If we exceed our goal, the parish gets back 100% of the overage. Many people are aware that dioceses typically take a percentage of the weekly collection from every parish for their operating expenses. Many, however, are not aware that our diocese keeps that percentage very low compared to other dioceses, some of which have assessments approaching 20% of the Sunday collection! Our Bishop relies on this appeal to run various diocesan programs and ministries including education of seminarians, pro-life activities, and works of charity towards those in need.
