

36th ANNUAL BISHOP'S APPEAL

This is pledge week for our Annual Bishop's Appeal. Our goal for this year is \$17,980.15. If we exceed our goal, the parish gets back 100% of the overage. Many people are aware that dioceses typically take a percentage of the weekly collection from every parish for their operating expenses. Many, however, are not aware that our diocese keeps that percentage very low compared to other dioceses, some of which have assessments approaching 20% of the Sunday collection! Our Bishop relies on this appeal to run various diocesan programs and ministries including education of seminarians, prolife activities, and works of charity towards those in need. Please be generous in supporting the work of Bishop Rhoades, and know that your pledges are appreciated! MICHAELMAS—SEPT 29

Michael is pronounced to rhyme with "nickel" so the correct pronunciation sounds something like "mickelmas." Schools in England had what was called the "Michaelmas term," which at Oxford University, for example, begins on October 1 and ends on Dec. 17. Although not generally in use in the United States, the Supreme Court begins its 9-month session on October 1, a few days after the feast of St. Michael. Note that although the feast is that of the dedication of the church of St. Michael, in fact, the feast is of St. Michael and indeed all the angels.
