




SACRED HEART PARISH

#### JANUARY 6—EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

We will have a **12:00 PM** High Mass on Friday, Jan. 6, to celebrate the Epiphany of our Lord, one of the most important feasts of the liturgical year and the conclusion of the 12 days of Christmas. Savoie will be away assisting in the evening for a solemn mass in the presence of the Bishop up at St Stanislaus Catholic Church in South Bend.

#### **EPIPHANY BLESSING**

Blessed chalk is available on the tables by the entrances to the church for those who desire to bless their homes with the traditional epiphany house blessing. Feel free to take. The abridged blessing that can be done by the head of the household is as follows:

#### **Leader:** Let us pray.

Bless, O Lord God almighty, this home, that in it there may be health, purity, the strength of victory, humility, goodness and mercy, the fulfillment of Thy law, the thanksgiving to God the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. And may this blessing remain upon this home and upon all who dwell herein. Through Christ our Lord.

#### All: Amen.

After the prayer of the blessing are recited, The initials of the Magi are inscribed upon the doors with the blessed chalk. (The initials, C, M, B, can also be interpreted as the Latin phrase "Christus mansionem benedicat" which means "Christ bless this house".)

Example: 20 + C + M + B + 23
