CHRISTMAS MATINS

This year, we will be celebrating Matins before the midnight Mass. This is the traditional night office of the church, consisting of psalms and readings from scripture and the fathers of the church. It is rather lengthy, so no one should feel obligated to attend the entire service (especially where small children are involved), but the chants are very beautiful. Consider this ancient ceremony of the faithful gathering in prayer and meditation as a true vigil (keeping watch) until midnight, waiting for the return of the Lord. Feel free to arrive at anytime during Matins. A sermon will immediately follow and after which the lights will be cut in the church for the celebration of midnight mass by candle light.
