MASS REQUESTS

If you desire a Mass to be celebrated for a particular intention, please place the offering along with the specific intention in writing in an envelope clearly marked **Mass Intention** and place it in the collection basket or hand it to the priest. For intentions for a specific individual, make sure to specify whether the person is living or deceased. If deceased, please provide the anniversary of death so that, schedule permitting, a requiem mass may be said on that day. Alternatively, you can approach the pastor or bring or mail the request to the church. **We do not accept telephoned or emailed requests.** Everything must be together at the time the request is made. Please note that Mass stipends are NOT tax-deductible according to IRS regulations.

Please join your fellow parishioners for coffee and donuts after the 8:00 AM Mass on the first Sunday of the month, or after the 10:00 AM Mass on the first and third Sundays of the month. This is also the time to visit our small lending library of good Catholic books and media. This is located on the first floor of the school building (Classroom #5).
