

Active registered parishioners should contact the Pastor at least six Months in advance of the date.



For intentions for a specific individual, make sure to specify whether the person is living or deceased. If deceased, please provide the anniversary of death so that, schedule permitting, a requiem mass may be said on that day. Alternatively, you can approach the pastor or bring or mail the request to the church. **We do not accept telephoned or emailed requests.** Everything must be together at the time the request is made. Please note that Mass stipends are NOT tax-deductible according to IRS regulations.
