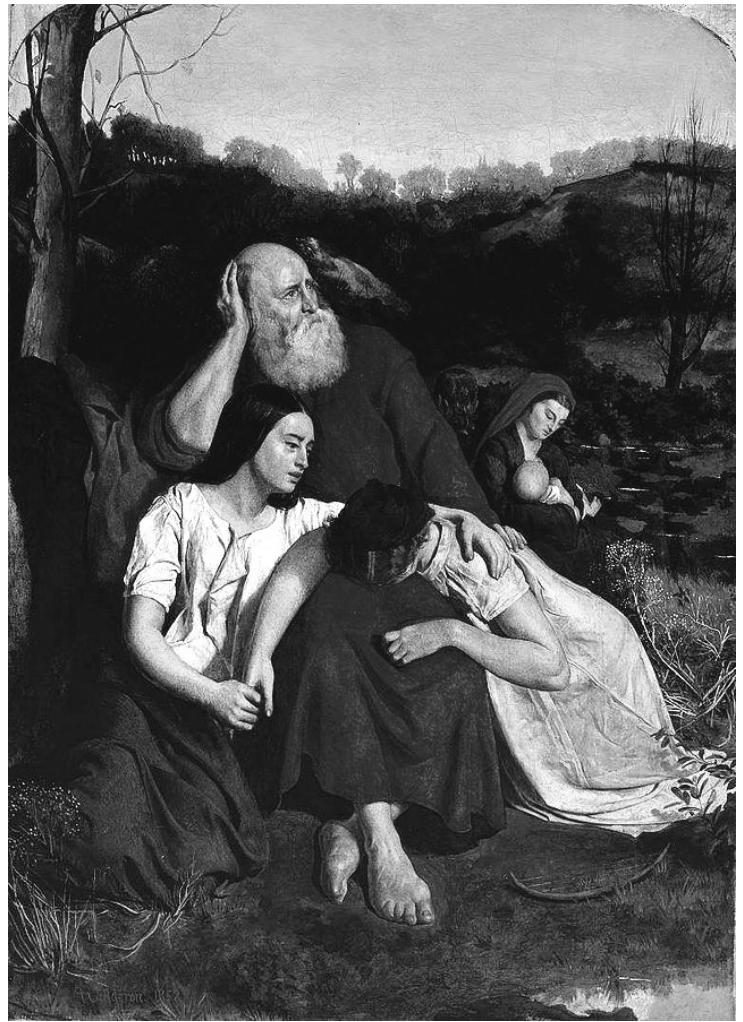


Image: Philip Hermogenes Calderon (1833-1898),

REGISTRATION DRIVE

If you derive benefit from the common good of Sacred Heart Parish and contribute to Sacred Heart—please register. Practically speaking, registration simply changes the virtue that the priest exercises when ministering to you. I have an obligation under justice to minister to those who are under my charge (registered). I use charity for all other Catholics who are under the charge of another. Just as priests have to be under somebody in authority, so do all Catholics. You should be registered somewhere—too belong somewhere. Where you are registered should be where you derive benefit from the common good of that church, and therefore contribute to that common good according to your abilities.

We have parishioners who have been registered for years who reside outside the diocese; Ohio, Michigan, Lafayette. I say this to alleviate any confusion for those who have refrained from registering because they don't "technically" reside within the territory of the diocese. You should be in our directory, you should be counted as souls under Sacred Heart's charge, you should be registered in my system.
