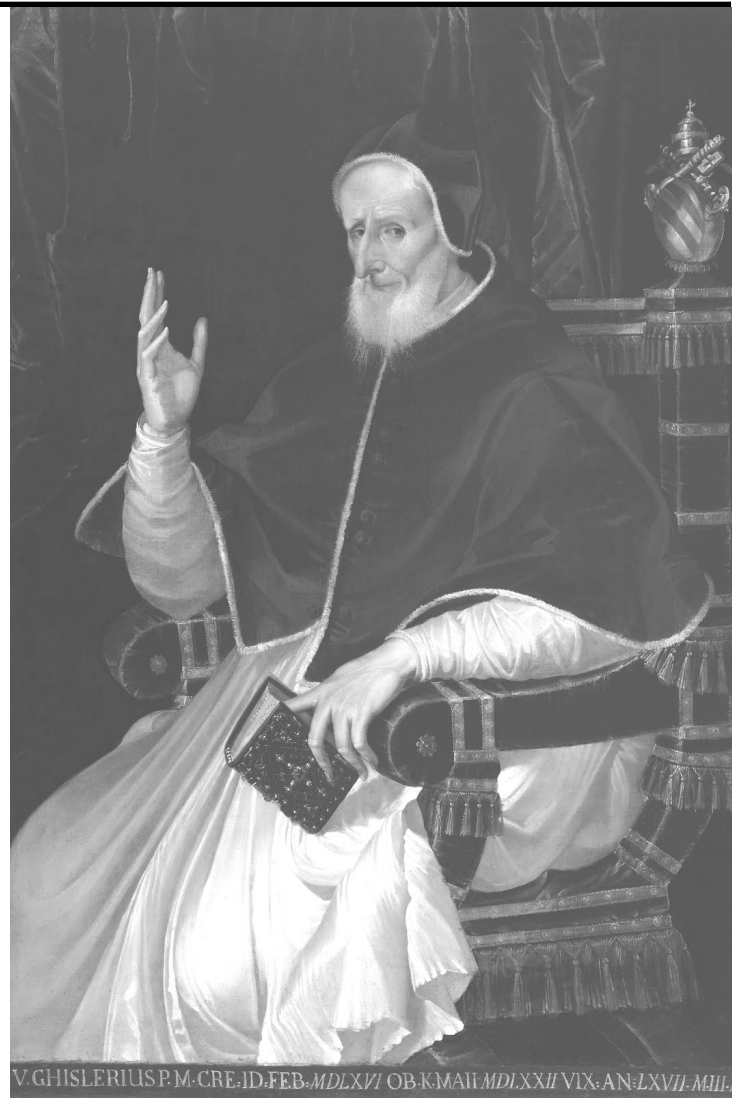

On May 7, 2023, Mr. Florian Smith, representing the Assumption Sisters of Nairobi (ASN), will speak at our Masses. He will be making an appeal, on behalf of the Assumption Sisters, to contribute to the ongoing work of the Sisters in Nairobi, Kenya. Florian is a lay person who has worked closely with the ASN for over 15 years. The mission of the ASN is to educate the disenfranchised, the poorest of the poor, especially women, in Africa, from a primary school level through secondary school. Only recently have the Sisters begun the enormous project of starting a school for poor young boys who cannot go to school and then, without education, begin a life of drug abuse and crime. Further expanded curriculums are planned as money and buildings become available. Please be generous in your donations to the Assumption Sisters mission.
