This meeting's talk will examine the character of St Joan of Arc, her complexity and internal struggle arising from the fog of faith. An in depth treatment of her mass will provide the material for a lecture on the composition of new liturgical texts inspired from tradition and creatively adapting new material inspired from the Saint. *“Every scribe who has been disciplined in the kingdom of heaven is like a homeowner who brings out of his storeroom new treasures as well as old.”* (Mt 13:52) The Mass of Joan of Arc illustrates this process of increasing our understanding of traditional texts by making old texts speak with a new voice.
