FORTY HOURS DEVOTION

Following the feast of Corpus Christi this year the Diocese of Fort Wayne South Bend will enter into the second year of a three year "Eucharistic Revival." In order to inculcate a deeper devotion to the Eucharist every parish in the Diocese has chosen to do a 40 hours devotion. I have chosen to commence our parish's 40 hour devotion following the 6pm Mass on Friday, June 16, on the Feast of the Sacred Heart. Exposition of the Blessed sacrament will be continuous until the High Mass on Sunday June 18. A sign up sheet is available to ensure that all the hours of exposition will have at least two parishioners.

I know many of you do not live close to our parish so the time investment is especially acute. I ask you to reflect on the fact that we do not do this devotion very frequently. The rarity of the event should inspire a rare display of devotion. Remember that this devotional will be linked to our patronal feast and the month of June is dedicated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus so it is appropriate on many levels. Let us be generous with our time and execute this public act of religion to increase our devotion in the Eucharist and to offer reparation for the secular crimes against nature which are parodied during the month of June.

Our enemy does not tire nor sleep, may we also respond in kind and keep watch.
