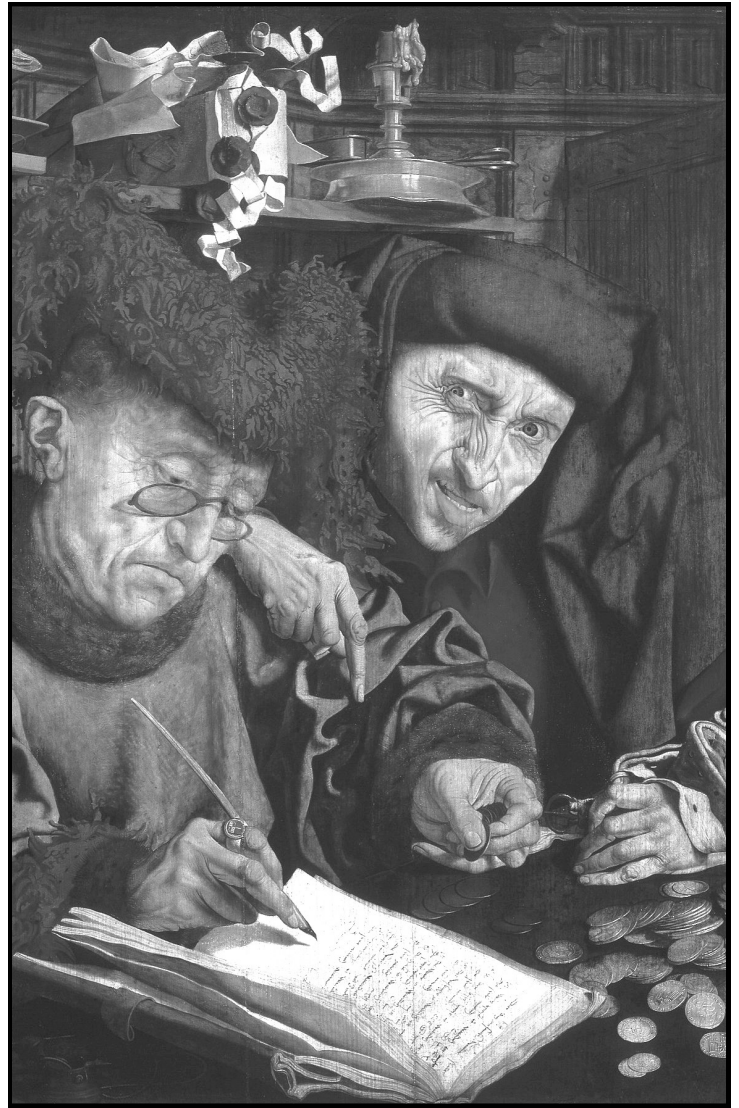

FORTY HOURS DEVOTION

Thank you all for your participation at our 1st Forty Hour Devotion at Sacred Heart Church. It was a tremendous success on many levels. I have personally heard private testimony from many of you of positive spiritual experiences. I had a sign in sheet present during the 40 hours for our own parish assessment and I would like to share with you an overall picture of our parish during this devotion.

Not including the mass attendance on Saturday and Sunday 160 unique individuals/families signed in. That is almost two thirds of our congregation, a congregation which is quite dispersed around the diocese and into Ohio. In total there were 225 hours of adoration performed by individuals/families. That is an average of 5.6 adorers for every hour.

I am edified by your devotion, zeal, and spirit of sacrifice. Sometimes we can lose sight of the positive things that happen secretly around us. We get inundated and consumed by negative news. Very often we can get irrationally jaded at the effects of grace in the world since we don't see it's workings and we personally suffer great hardships.

Your devotion and participation is a testament to grace and a source of light for your encouragement. You are not alone in your love of God. And in spite of everything trying to destroy devotion to the Eucharist, the presence of God, the need of prayer, true exercise of reverence, and authentic Christian piety in our world—it can be found alive and well in our parish.

I say this not to give you pride, rather give you confidence and hope in the workings of God. If such indications of grace can be found on the south side of Fort Wayne during the month of June ... we know it IS and CAN happen anywhere.
